Exodus 5:20–23 They met Moses and Aaron, who were waiting for them, as they came out from Pharaoh; ²¹ and they said to them, "The LORD look on you and judge, because you have made us stink in the sight of Pharaoh and his servants, and have put a sword in their hand to kill us." ²² Then Moses turned to the LORD and said, "O Lord, why have you done evil to this people? Exodus 3:13–15 Then Moses said to God, "If I come to the people of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' what shall I say to them?" ¹⁴ God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." Exodus 6:5 Moreover, <u>I have heard</u> the groaning of the people of Israel whom the Egyptians hold as slaves, and I have remembered my covenant.

Exodus 6:6 Say therefore to the people of Israel, 'I am the LORD, and <u>I will bring</u> you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and <u>I will deliver you from slavery to them</u>, and <u>I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great acts of judgment.</u>

Exodus 6:7 <u>I will take you to be my people</u>, and <u>I will be your God</u>, and <u>you shall know that I am the LORD your God</u>, who has brought you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
