#### Judges 18:18-31

#### I. Doctrine: Idolaters are forced to put a Lot of \_\_\_\_\_ Into *Managing* their Wayward gods

True God's Being Really Is, (Job 38:4)

vv. 18-21

(Jn. 16:26-27)

B. –We Gladly \_\_\_\_\_ Him as Adopted and Happy Chil-  
dren, (Gal. 4:4-6)

Key Verse—v. 31: “*So they set up for themselves Micah's carved image which he made, all the time that the house of God was in Shiloh.*”
