Introduction

- I. This passage teaches the exalted position of our Savior, as a result of His ascension.
- II. Psalm 110 is one of the clearly Messianic Psalms.

### **My Lord at Jehovah's Right Hand**

#### **I. The Exalted Position**

A. The text identifies the exalted position of our Lord Jesus Christ in two ways:

B. David confesses this Lord is "my Lord". What does this mean?

#### **II. The Powerful Rule**

A. The powerful rule of our ascended Christ is expressed in the text this way, "Sit thou at my right hand until I make thy enemies thy footstool."

B. With David, may we confess the progressive rule of Christ by which He brings His enemies to be His footstool.

#### **III. The Needed Comfort**

A. David found comfort, as he confessed the coming of this Lord.

B. We have a great comfort in knowing that Christ is our Lord Who is seated at God's right hand, ruling over all things to make the wicked His footstool.
