## *Find Your Contentment in Jesus* Philippians 4:10-13

Main Point:

While discontentment is a problem for all of us, learn to be content by finding it in Jesus alone.

1. Discontentment is a problem for all of us.

2. Yet discontentment is to have no place in your life.

3. Instead, you must learn to be content at all times.

4. True contentment is found only in Jesus Christ.

**1 Timothy 6:6-8** <sup>6</sup> Now there is great gain in godliness with contentment, <sup>7</sup> for we brought nothing into the world, and we cannot take anything out of the world. <sup>8</sup> But if we have food and clothing, with these we will be content. (ESV)

**Hebrews 13:5** <sup>5</sup> *Let your* conduct *be* without covetousness; *be* content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." (NKJV)

**Luke 12:15**  $^{15}$  ... "Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses." (NKJV)
