- B. Do not leave me to my oppressors
- C. Be surety for Your servant
- D. Do not let the arrogant oppress me

II. Yahweh's covenant faithfulness to His servant (123-124)

- A. My eyes grow weary
- B. Do loyal love and teach statutes

III. Yahweh's commitment to educate His servant (125)

- A. Give me understanding
- B. So that I may know Your decrees
