Acts 20:1 After the uproar ceased, Paul sent for the disciples, and after encouraging them, he said farewell and departed for Macedonia. 2 When he had gone through those regions and had given them much encouragement, he came to Greece. 3 There he spent three months, and when a plot was made against him by the Jews as he was about to set sail for Syria, he decided to return through Macedonia. 4 Sopater the Berean, son of Pyrrhus, accompanied him; and of the Thessalonians, Aristarchus and Secundus; and Gaius of Derbe, and Timothy; and the Asians, Tychicus and Trophimus. 5 These went on ahead and were waiting for us at Troas, 6 but we sailed away from Philippi after the days of Unleavened Bread, and in five days we came to them at Troas, where we stayed for seven days. ## **Application Questions**

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **Philippians 2:1-2**. How would you describe, to a non-Christian, the unique sort of support, encouragement, and camaraderie Christians enjoy by being highly committed participants in Christ's church?
- 2. Read **Philippians 2:3-4**. How would you describe, to a non-Christian, the unique challenge (and the divine empowerment to meet the challenge) that comes with being a provider of that sort of selfless encouragement?
- 3. Read **Romans 15:4-6** and **Acts 15:30-35**. What sort of words, concepts, and thoughts can you work to communicate that will reflect biblical truth to other Christians, and will build them up and strengthen them?
- 4. Read **Matthew 26:36-38** and **2 Timothy 4:9-15**. Why is it foolish to think it is fine for us to spend less time with other Christians, and not more? What are some advantages that face-to-face time with other Christians provides?
- 5. Read **Deuteronomy 1:38**. What brother or sister in Christ is facing a challenging task, hard situation, or a prolonged difficulty, whom you can encourage this week? How will you do that?
