086 - Revelation 4 and 5 - The Trinity - 2023-06-21

TEXT

Revelation 4:1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.

Here is the statement that the Revelation will be about things that were in the future. Those prophecies would be of very startling, troubling events to come. In order that we can face those things to come with joy and hope, John was given a great vision of God, so we always can know that all the troubling things that will happen in the future are under His control.

Last time, I read aloud all of chapters 4 and 5. This evening, we will refer to certain verses, to show that the vision of God as Trinity: the one true God in His three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

First, a look back to

Revelation 3:21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

Jesus just having mentioned Himself sitting with His Father in His throne, the vision that came to John was of that very thing: Jesus with His Father in His throne.

Chapter 4 - God the Father on His Throne

Revelation 4:2 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne.

Revelation 4:8 And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.

Revelation 4:11 Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

Chapter 5 - Jesus On the Throne with God the Father

Revelation 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

Revelation 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

Revelation 5:9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for <u>thou wast slain</u>, and hast redeemed us to God by <u>thy blood</u> out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

Chapters 4 and 5 - The Holy Spirit

Revelation 4:5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Reve 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

In the relations among the Father, the Son, and the Spirit of God, the Bible says that the Spirit is from the Father and from the Son.

John 15:26 But when the Comforter is come, whom <u>I will send unto you from the Father</u>, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:

Galatians 4:6 And because ye are sons, <u>God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son</u> into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.

1689.2.3 In this divine and infinite Being there are three subsistences, the Father, the Word or Son, and Holy Spirit, of one substance, power, and eternity, each having the whole divine essence, yet the essence undivided: the Father is of none, neither begotten nor proceeding; the Son is eternally begotten of the Father; the Holy Spirit proceeding from the Father and the Son
