Three marks of a Complete Church

- 1. A Mature Church **embodies** God's Grace (verse 1-6)
 - a. God's grace calls us to **purity** (verses 1-2)
 - b. God's grace calls us to <u>unity</u> (verses 3-6) Of the many God has made one.
 - c. God grace calls us to **community** (verse 1-6).
- 2. A Mature church **employs** God's gifts (verse 7-11)
 - a. The gifts are for **every person** (verse 7)
 - b. The gifts came at a high price (verses 8-10)
 - c. The gifts to the church are **gifted people** (verse 11)
- 3. A Mature Church **experiences** Godly Growth (verse 12-16)
 - a. A church is supposed to be **built up** like a strong man verse 12
 - b. A church is supposed to **measure up** like a strong man verse 13.
 - i. A complete body has all its parts
 - ii. A complete body has all its **parts functioning**
 - iii. A complete body has all its parts obeying the Head
 - c. A church is supposed to **grow up** to be a Strong man verse 14-16
 - i. A mature man is not easily **tricked** (verse 14)
 - ii. A mature man is speaking **the truth** (verse 15)
 - iii. A mature man has all his members working together! (verse16)
