Our pastor does not lead our church like a CEO or a pope. Rather, we are led and cared for by a "session," a group of mature, Christian men that serve together with our pastor. Our elders and our pastor are, themselves, under the authority of the elders and pastors of other churches in our denomination. We are affiliated with a reformed Christian denomination called the Orthodox Presbyterian Church.


**10:00 A.M. | MORNING WORSHIP** | This morning, Ruling Elder Michael Smith will fill our pulpit while the Holdas are on vacation.
