1. God is wise

<u>Matt 22.37–40</u> And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.<u>38</u> This is the great and first commandment.<u>39</u> And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.<u>40</u> On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets."

<u>1 John 5.3</u> For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome.

<u>1 John 3.16</u> By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers.

<u>1 John 4.19</u> We love because he first loved us.

<u>1 John 3.18</u> Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth.
