He has a Plan Exodus 23:20-33

He leads us with:

I. Instruction – "do all that I speak" (vs. 20-25)

In regards to:

- A. Plans "keep thee in the way...which I have prepared"
- **B.** Protection "I will be an enemy unto thy enemies"
- C. Piety -"Thou shalt not bow down to their gods"

II. Intervention - "thy days I will fulfill" (vs. 25-31) In regards to:

- A. Sickness "I will take sickness away"
- **B.** Sanity "I will send my fear before thee"
- *C. Schedule* "*I* will not drive them before thee in one year"

III. Insulation - "it will surely be a snare unto thee" (vs. 32-33) *In regards to being:*

- A. Indebted "Thou shalt make no covenants with them"
- B. Infested "They shall not dwell in thy land"
- C. Invested "if thou serve their gods"
