INTRODUCTION: WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A CHURCH?

A. COVENANTS DEFINED

- 1. GENERALLY: AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN TWO PARTIES
- 2. DIVINE: ... SOVEREIGNLY ADMINISTERED, SEALED IN BLOOD
- 3. Church: Pledge made one to another, before God,
 to live in accord with the commands of the
 Scriptures

B. God's Covenant with Believers

- 1. THE OLD COVENANT (ADAM, NOAH, ABRAHAM, MOSES, DAVID)
- 2. THE NEW COVENANT IN CHRIST
- 3. THE NEW COVENANT CREATED THE CHURCH

C. OUR COVENANT WITH ONE ANOTHER

- 1. IS DEFINED BY THE BIBLE
- 2. IS DEMANDED NOT BY OTHERS, BUT BY OUR LORD
- 3. LEADS TO DELIBERATE CHRISTIAN LIVING

D. PRACTICAL COVENANT ISSUES

- 1. 'COUNTER-CULTURAL' (NO MORE 'GO WITH FLOW')
- 2. COMMUNITY-ORIENTED (NO MORE "ON MY OWN")
- 3. COSTLY (NO MORE 'CHEAP' RELIGION)
- 4. CONTINUOUS (NO MORE 'FITS & STARTS')
