### Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- In verses 11-15 Paul continues to push out further what he has already been talking about. What has he been saying about Israel in chapters 9 - 11?
- How had Israel stumbled? What is the difference Paul was making between "stumble" and "fall"?
- What was Israel's "transgression"?
- How is it that by means of Israel's transgression salvation came to the Gentiles?
- What affect does Gentile salvation have on Israel?
- What further explanation does Paul give in verse 12-15 that fill out his point in verse 11?
- In verse 12-15, what implications does Paul bring forward from his point in verse 11?
- **Community Group Focus Question:** Set aside a minimum of 5 minutes before we meet to be still before God in order to hear Him in this passage of Scripture. Think about the truth God is revealing in this passage that in His administration He is not bringing about Israel's permanent bad, but in fact is working for the best of all mankind. How would God have this truth transform you, your thinking, and your doings? Ask Him. Listen. Take notes. With humility, thankfulness and for the purpose of our mutual edification, share what you have heard from God.
