Jonah: The Unforgiving Prophet Jonah 4:1-11

- I. <u>PROPHET</u>: "displeased...angry...sat" (vv.1-5) A. Displeased: "Jonah...became angry" (v.1)
 - **B. Despondent:** "please take my life" (vv.2-3) 1.Rebuke: "was not this what I said?" (v.2a)

2.Recognition: "I knew that You are..." (v.2b)

3.Resistance: "please take my life from me" (v.3)

B. Defiant: "Jonah went out...and sat" (vv.4-5)

II. <u>PRESSURE</u>: "appointed...compassion" (vv.6-11)

A. Appointments: "a plant...a worm...a wind" (vv.6-8) 1.Delight: "a plant...grew up...to be a shade" (v.6)

2.Demise: "a worm...attacked the plant" (v.7)

3.Discomfort: "a scorching east wind" (v.8)

B. Appeals: "good reason to be angry?" (vv.9-11) 1.Excuse: "I have good reason to be angry" (v.9)

- 2.Example: "you had compassion on the plant" (v.10)
- 3.Exhortation: "should I not have compassion" (v.11)
