#### Five Potential Stimulants to Joy

- 5. People (1 Thessalonians 2:19-20)

#### Four Distinctive Categories of Joy

- Circumstantial Joy (Psalm 126:1-3; Philippians 2:1-2;
  2 John 4)
- 2. Artificial Joy (Psalm 137:1-8)
- 3. Volitional Joy (Romans 12:15; Philippians 4:4; 1 Thessalonians 5:16)
- 4. Transcendent Joy (Nehemiah 8:10; John 15:11; Galatians 5:22-23)

#### Five Characteristics of Transcendent Joy

- 1. Its Value—Strength (Nehemiah 8:10)
- 2. Its Source—Jesus Christ (John 15:11)
- 3. Its Channel—the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23)
- 4. Its Nature—Inexpressible (1 Peter 1:8-9)
- 5. Its Duration—Forever (John 16:22)
