Three: GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY & PILATE'S RESPONSIBILITY

I. Pilate's Responsibility (v27)

v25-6 quote Psalm 2: rage against the Lord and His Anointed This fulfilled in Jesus' trial. Note particularly Pilate:

A. Started well

Refuse rubber stamp Sanhedrin's verdict

Acquitted Jesus 6x:

Jn 18:38 Lk 23:14-15 Lk 23:22 Jn 19:4 Jn 19:6 Matt 27:24

Tries to release Him 7x: Lk 23:4

Lk 23:14-16 Jn 18:38-39 Lk 23.22 Jn 19:4-6 Jn 19:12 Matt 24-25

B. Tries to escape responsibility 4x

Jn 18:31: you judge Lk 23:5-7: Herod

Mk 15:6-10: not Barabbas! Mt 27:24-25: innocent!

- C. Knew about Jesus before that morning
- D. Avoids Jesus' overtures
- E. Knows Jesus only accused out of envy (Matt 27:18)
- F. Ignores wife's warnings (from God!)
- G. Is deeply impressed by Jesus (egs Mt 27:12-14 "amazed"; Jn 19:6-7 hears His claim to be Son of God and does not laugh!)
- H. Hypocritical show of Roman "justice": then submits to mob rule

- I. What happened to Pilate afterward?
 - The guard and the empty tomb!
 Note the reason was because He said He would rise from the dead!
 - 2. Then hears of the resurrection
 - 3. The Samaritan incident in 36 AD
 - 4. Speculations on his end.
