## Introduction

- Certain institutions and organizations carry more clout than others.
- Who is your mentor? Who tutored you?
- The original apostles studied under the Master, Jesus Christ
- What about the apostle Paul? Where did he get his training? Who is his mentor?
- Paul claims to be a genuine apostle of Jesus Christ preaching an authoritative message. And he claims that no one taught him, but rather he was disciplined by Jesus Christ.
- But does the storyline of Paul's life back up his claims?
  - Nothing in Paul's Jewish upbringing accounts for his later ministry
  - Paul's personal encounter with Jesus Christ accounts for everything

## *The Training of the One: The Story continues....*

- A. **Immediately after conversion, Paul is baptized, publicly identifying himself as a follower of Jesus Christ.**  
Acts 9:18
- B. **Immediately after his baptism, Paul does not confer with "*flesh and blood*", but is led by the Spirit to the wilderness of Arabia to be trained by the Lord Himself.**
  1. "*Arabia*"—Mt. Sinai was in the Arabian wilderness—Gal. 4:25
  2. Paul had the resident teacher, the Holy Spirit, living within—John 15:26; 16:12-14
  3. Jesus Christ revealed truth directly to Paul
    - a. Information regarding the person and work of Christ—1 Cor. 11
    - b. "*Mysteries*"—truth concealed in the OT, revealed in the New
      - 1) The nature of the new life—Colossians 1:27-29
      - 2) The makeup of the church—Ephesians 3:2-9
      - 3) The rapture of the church—1 Thessalonians 4:15-17
      - 4) The resurrection of our bodies—1 Corinthians 15:51-53
  4. The need for us to learn in solitude, trained by the Spirit
- C. **After returning from the wilderness, Paul immediately begins preaching in the synagogues in Damascus that "*Jesus is the Son of GOD*"—Acts 9:20-22. He would eventually be run out of town!**
- D. **He makes a "*social call*" to Peter and James in Jerusalem—Galatians 1:18-19**
  1. "*Cold*" initial reception—Acts 9:26
  2. Intervention of Barnabas
- E. **Known only by name to the churches in Judea—Galatians 1:22-24**
