6 For **whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth.**

Proverbs 1:3 To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity;

guide in judgment: and the
meek will he teach his way.**

**James 1:19 Wherefore, my
beloved brethren, let every
man be **swift to hear**, slow to
speak, slow to wrath:**

-He that spareth his rod hateth his son: but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes.

-Correction is grievous unto him that forsaketh the way: and he that hateth reproof shall die.

-A scorner loveth not one that reproveth him: neither will he go unto the wise.

Proverbs 27:5 Open rebuke is better than secret love.
