 - ii) It is transformation Philippians 3:20-21; 1 Cor 15:51
 - d) Reunion 1 Thessalonians 4:17 (Together)
- 3) Initiates evaluation 2 Cor 5:10; Romans 14:10b-12;
 - a) To judge our <u>motives</u> Revelation 2:4
 - b) To test our works 1 Cor 3:12-15
- 4) Culminates in <u>Celebration</u> Revelation 19:6-9
 - a) A reason to <u>rejoice</u>
 - b) A royal <u>wedding</u>
 - c) A reinvention of lyrics
