- Confronted Israel and the prophets of Baal
- Sought the Lord to end a 3½ year drought
- Outran Ahab's chariot from Carmel to Jezreel

## 1 Kings 19-- Ran for his life

- Afraid; asked to die (2 Corinthians 1:8-9)
- Slept, ate and drank
- · Arose with renewed strength
- Went to meet with the Lord (19:8)
- Received supernatural nourishment
