## A Definition of Accountability:

### "giving account"

Spiritual accountability is another way to say that there are certain expectations (namely to walk worthy of the gospel and worthy of the Lord) in the Christian life. Therefore we are required to give an account, to answer for our decisions and our actions.

# LEVELS OF ACCOUNTABILITY TO GOD

### **1. PERSONAL**

We are accountable to God Himself.

Romans 14:12

Hebrews 4:13

When we ask for prayer, ask for advice, share our burdens and struggles, we are asking others to help us so that when we give an answer to God it will be a good one.

### 2. PASTORAL

We are accountable to spiritual leaders.

Hebrews 13:17 Acts 20:28

## **3. MUTUAL**

We are accountable to one another.

Galatians 6:1 1 Thessalonians 5:14 Hebrews 3:13; 10:24-25 James 5:19 Jesus didn't commission us to produce parrots who can repeat what He said. He commissioned us to make disciples who will obey what He said.
