Theme: Man for all his knowledge and wisdom, refuses to honor God and does not know God – and with his darkened mind (on his own), can't. But God has graciously provided a more glorious *revelation* of Himself and His way of redemption.

Background/Introduction: Last week – God's self-revelation in nature – *Natural/General Revelation*. Revealing His divine nature & eternal power – but Rejected by fallen mankind. Our only hope? God's *Special Revelation* in the Word of God, Living and Written

I. The Wisdom of the Age

- A. Natural man's wisdom
 - 1. I don't need God (Emphasis of Romans 1:18ff)
 - a. Judgment (Genesis 3)
 - Death, driven away, pain
 - b. Moral depravity Enormous consequences
 - Seen from beginning to the end of the Bible
 - 2. A corrupt (but intact) intellect
 - a. Great capabilities
 - Advancing knowledge of things
 - b. Great deficiencies (7,8)
 - No advance of the knowledge of God or self
- B. The modern mind (14)
 - 1. Secular Bend away from God
 - God/religion is pushed out of culture/society
 - 2. Futile in their thinking (Romans 1:21)
 - a. Moral relativists
 - b. Radical pluralists
 - c. Pragmatists

NOTE: The "natural" mind is corrupted. (14) It will not, and cannot accept things of the Spirit.

II. The Wisdom of God

- A. Special revelation
 - 1. Redemption in history
 - God breaks into human history, coming into the world in the flesh
 - 2. Revelation in the Word written, living, active (Hebrews 4:12)
 - a. Points us to the Redeemer (John 5:39; Luke 24:27)
 - b. Shows Him in this life in ministry and work
 - c. Shows His continuing work in the world
 - 3. Holy Spirit's application of the work of Christ to the mind and heart (11-13)
- B. The foolishness of preaching (1-5)
 - Power to transform natural man into spiritual man (1:18)
 - Not world's wisdom but God's power! (2:4,5)
- C. The ministry of the Spirit (10-12)

III. The Mind of Christ

- A. Unknown/unavailable to the "natural" person (8)
- B. Given to the "spiritual" person
 - To have the mind of Christ is to be alive spiritually
 - It is the work of the Holy Spirit
- C. Internal testimony
 - Made to see self in light of truth
- D. Putting it to the test
