God's Gift of Forgiveness

I. The Gracious Gift

A. This gracious gift is God's promise that He will not punish us for our sins or see us in our sin (Is. 38:17; Ps. 103:10, 12).

B. This promise of God is a gracious gift, as we read in Eph. 1:7.

II. The Needed Confession

A. The way God makes this promise to us is through the confession of our sin (Psalm 32).

B. God calls us to confess our sins! This is a part of true repentance, which includes 2 things:

- A. Those who know they are forgiven much will deal mercifully with those who sin against them.
- B. Those who know forgiveness live to express their thanks to God.
