QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

1. Why would Lloyd-Jones call Matthew 6 “one of the most uncomfortable chapters to read in the entire Scriptures”?
2. What is hypocrisy? What form of hypocrisy is Jesus warning against here?
3. Is Jesus saying we can never do good deeds or religious acts of worship where we might be seen by other people? If not, what is He saying?
4. In what ways are we particularly tempted to serve God so that others might see us and be impressed by us?
5. What is the reward of those who live for the applause and approval of other people?
6. What is the fear that alone can deliver us from the fear of man?
7. In this life, do we ever have perfectly pure hearts in our service to God? What should this lead us to do?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

1. Which of the questions from Ed Welch were most convicting to me? What is the most prominent way the fear of man manifests itself in my life?
2. Is the glorification and enjoyment of God the predominant motivation of my external acts of devotion?
3. Do I need to repent of hypocrisy (an external life that doesn't accord with my internal life)?
