

RESPONSE

- More than a metaphor..."not merely like...really are"
- •We are *Dead* in Christ
- •We are Raised in Christ
 - •We are *Hidden* in Christ
- •This is a identity together, and what we believe about one another
- •Therefore, do not be bound by chains of man-made religion (of any sort), but live in the resurrection-life as those who have not yet been fully revealed
- •The importance of Scripture and Prayer in shaping us

So if you're serious about living this new resurrection life with Christ, act like it. Pursue the things over which Christ presides. Don't shuffle along, eyes to the ground, absorbed with the things right in front of you.

Look up, and be alert to what is going on around Christ—that's where the action is. See things from his perspective.

Your old life is dead. Your new life, which is your real life even though invisible to spectators—is with Christ in God. He is your life.

When Christ (your real life, remember) shows up again on this earth, you'll show up, too—the real you, the glorious you.
