

## Life Group Discussion Guide Faith in Practice How does faith work in relational conflict? - James 4:1-12 Scott Paulson - June 4, 2023

#### Main thought:

The cause of relational conflict with others and with God comes from within us. By God's grace we can live differently; humbly submitting ourselves to God and not slandering others.

## Notes:

Recognizing and resolving relational conflict	
Relational difficulty with people	(vv. 1-3)
Relational difficulty with <u>God</u>	(vv. 4-6)
Responding differently to <u>God</u> Responding differently to <u>people</u>	(vv. 7-10) (vv. 11-12)

## Slander defined

Any derogatory statement, true or untrue, to diminish and/or harm another person, intentionally or unintentionally

## Humble people...

- Examine their own **faults**.
- Are slow to speak of other's <u>faults</u>.
- <u>Stick</u> with others and don't quickly <u>separate</u> when it's hard.
- Are <u>flexible</u> rather than <u>dogmatic</u>.
- Aren't afraid of **confronting**, but they don't like it.
- Don't sit in self-pity.

## Digging In

Read James 4:1-12, and discuss the following questions.

• What stood out to you from this passage?



- What does James point to as a cause for relational conflict? Why is this important to recognize? (vv. 1-2)
- Why does James say we don't ask God? And when we do ask God our prayers aren't answered? What prevents this according to James? (v. 3)
- Why and how does friendship with the world cause conflict and enmity between us and God? (vv. 4-6)
- How can we live differently and avoid relational difficulties according to James?
- Why is humility such a critical characteristic when addressing relational conflict?
