God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

1 Corinthians 1:9

- A church <u>exists</u> by God's call His particular possession (verses 1-3)
 - a. Leaders are called by God will
 - **b.** Saints are called **to be holy**
 - c. Saints are called to unity
 - d. Everyone is called by **God's favor**
- 2. A church **enjoys** all God's gifts by His mighty provision (verses 4-9)
 - a. God gives churches the necessary **gifts** -while we wait for Jesus
 - b. God gives churches a **guarantee** for when we stand before Jesus
- 3. A church <u>fails</u> when men divide it it shows no manifestation of <u>God's power</u> (verses 10-17)
 - The message of the cross is rendered powerless when a congregation:
 - a. Forgets about Christ like **<u>humility</u>** The mind of Christ
 - b. Forms cliques around <u>personalities</u> I am of Paul, Apollos, Cephas or Christ
 - c. Fails to emphasize the meaning of, "<u>Christianity</u>" Was Paul crucified for you?

The cross of Christ is the answer to the crisis of disunity at any church.
