14. What are some common misconceptions people entertain today about what it means to follow Christ?
15. What do you think are some things (attitudes, actions, situations) that stunt your commitment to Christ?
16. In what ways could you be a more committed follower of Christ?
17. Evaluate Jesus' response to the second guy. Callous? Sensitive? Realistic? Tactful? How authoritative?
18. Do you find anything inconvenient about following Jesus?
