Sermon: Luke 24:44-49

The physical Word explains the written Word for the plan of salvation.

We see:

- 1. Jesus, the Christ, fulfilled the written Word for the plan of salvation (44-46).
- 2. The plan of salvation includes the ongoing official preaching of the Word (vv.47,48).
- 3. The risen and ruling Lord gives *power* to be *witnesses* (v.49).

The Heidelberg Catechism

- **<u>32. Q.</u>** Why are you called a *Christian*?
- **A.** Because I am a member of Christ by faith[1] and thus share in His anointing,[2] so that I may as prophet confess His Name,[3] as priest present myself a living sacrifice of thankfulness to Him,[4] and as king fight with a free and good conscience against sin and the devil in this life,[5] and hereafter reign with Him eternally over all creatures.[6]

- **<u>86.</u> Q.** Since we have been delivered from our misery by grace alone through Christ, without any merit of our own, why must we yet do good works?
- **<u>A.</u>** Because Christ, having redeemed us by His blood, also renews us by His Holy Spirit to be His image, so that with our whole life we may show ourselves thankful to God for His benefits,[1] and He may be praised by us.[2] Further, that we ourselves may be assured of our faith by its fruits,[3] and that by our godly walk of life we may win our neighbors for Christ.[4]


