The Baptism of Jesus

Mark 1:9-11

Introduction / Setting "The beginning of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God..."

**Mark's object in the Gospel is to present Jesus in His daily life "in the awe-inspiring grandeur of His human personality, as a man who was also the incarnate, the wonder-working Son of God...

**Our passage presents the Lord's first recorded appearance since He was twelve years old in the temple...

**He came in those days...as promised and long awaited... Luke 2:25 cf. Isaiah 59:20; Psalm 98:4

**When Jesus came everything changed...

I. <u>The Special Significance of Jesus Baptism by John in the Jordan River</u>

A. He came to John...

- 1. John's baptism was one of repentance and confession of sins...
- 2. John humbly preached Christ... vs. 6-8
- 3. The people were baptized publicly confessing their sins...

B. Why then was Jesus Baptized by John in the Jordan River?

- 1. John had the very same question... I.E. Matthew 3:13
- It was to fulfill all righteousness... *Matthew 3:15* To make actual (fulfill) God's plan of perfect righteousness...
- C. Jesus was sinless... II Corinthians 5:21; I Peter 2:21-22; Hebrews 7:26-27
- D. The Reasons Consistent with fulfilling all righteousness for Jesus being baptized by John in the Jordan River...
- 1. A public declaration of who He was...
- 2. A public dedication to the purpose for which He came...
- 3. A public demonstration of identifying with those He came to save...

Important Point:

II. <u>The Supernatural Sequence of Events Following the Baptism of Jesus by John in the Jordan River</u>

Note: "And when he came up out of the water..."

Lesson: Baptism is by immersion in water... *i.e. John 3:23; with Acts 8:37ff*

A. The Heavens opened...

B. The Spirit Descended...

Observations: Here we have an anointing...

- 1. A picture of sacrifice... Leviticus 5:17 cf. Luke 2:24
- 2. Doves are associated with gentleness and peace... Isaiah 42:1-3 cf. Isaiah 9:6
- *Lesson:* Today is the day of salvation!

Question: Why was it necessary for the Holy Spirit to come upon Jesus at His baptism?

1. He came to live as a man—even a servant... He is the "second-Adam..."Romans 5:12He needed the power of the Holy Spirit, see Philippians 2:5-8

Ephesians 5:18 cf. John 14:12

2. He is not only our Savior, but our glorious example...

Observation: Every true believer in Christ has the Holy Spirit... Romans 8:9; I Corinthians 12:13

3. To fulfill perfectly the Scriptures... Isaiah 11:1-5

C. The Approval of the Father...

- 1. Here is eternal truth...
- 2. The Father will express public approval again in Matthew 17:5
- 3. He is pleased...
- a. Encouragement for John and others...
- b. Encouragement for Jesus...

Application:
