Sermon: "Real Reformers Fight!" What's Wrong With You People? Pt. 10

**I Text:**

Old Covenant: *Judges 3:1-11*

New Covenant: *Acts 10*

**II Doctrine:**

The living God tests the faith of Israel by leaving their enemies in the land. Those who have not tasted spiritual and physical warfare with Satanists will now be tested. The new generation will have to learn to fight the Devil, the flesh, and the world for their God.

God's people are not faithful to the covenant and profane themselves with God's enemies. They worship the false God of diversity, and intermarry with the Canaanites, which leads to spiritual apostasy. God's people must be unified and not diversified in their loyalty to God. Anything else leads to judgment and bondage.

God shows a merciful heart and sends a Judge to deliver his people from bondage. There are times where men of God need to physically fight to protect and deliver their people from evil. Violence is always the last resort in our defense, but strict pacifism is sinful.

**III Comparing Scripture With Scripture:**

1) The living God tests the faith of Israel by leaving their enemies in the land. Those who have not tasted spiritual and physical warfare with Satanists will now be tested. The new generation will have to learn to fight the Devil, the flesh, and the world for their God. (*Judges 3:1-4; 1 Corinthians 5:9-13*)

2) God's people are not faithful to the covenant and profane themselves with God's enemies. They worship the false God of diversity, and intermarry with the Canaanites, which leads to spiritual apostasy. God's people must be unified and not diversified in their loyalty to God. Anything else leads to judgment and bondage. (*Judges 3:5-8; Ephesians 4:1-6*)

3) God shows a merciful heart and sends a Judge to deliver his people from bondage. There are times where men of God need to physically fight to protect and deliver their people from evil. Violence is always the last resort in our defense, but strict pacifism is sinful. (*Judges 3:9-11; Acts 10:1-8;*)<https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Centurion>)
