Misunderstanding the value of worldly wisdom.

- God had declared through the prophet that He would render worldly wisdom futile.
 - 1 Cor 1:19
 - Is 29:14:
- God had done so.
 - 1 Cor 1:20-25
- God's calling of believers illustrated the futility of worldly wisdom.
 - 1 Cor 1:26-29

Misunderstanding the Nature of True Wisdom

- True wisdom is from God

- True wisdom is given by the Holy Spirit
 - 1 Cor 2:10-13

Paul's way: Not with persuasive words.

The Corinthian way: Walking in worldly wisdom.

- Worldly wisdom deludes, takes captive, defrauds.

 - Rom 8:6

- Worldly wisdom quenches the Spirit.
 - Gal 5:20
 - Eph 2:13, 19
 - Eph 4:13
