Resurrection in 2 Cor 4 New Creation, Light, Life, Power...

Examine the Scriptures (Be Berean!)

- Creation Context Gen 1:3
- Close Context: 2 Cor 1-3, 5
- Psalm 116:1-9

Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- **Community Group Discussion:** Paul frequently speaks about the resurrection of Christ and our share in it (both now in our spirits and then in our bodies) without using the words "resurrection" or "raised". This can "hide" resurrection as the foundation of a building is hidden beneath the rest of the building. Reading 2 Corinthians 4 (and the surrounding chapters of 1-5), what other words, phrases and topics does Paul use which have under them the truth of the resurrection? How does 2 Cor 4 add to your understanding of the gospel of the resurrection?

Memory & Meditation Passage

7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, so that the surpassing greatness of the power will be of God and not from ourselves; **8** we *are* afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not despairing; **9** persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed; **10** always carrying about in the body the dying of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body. **11** For we who live are constantly being delivered over to death for Jesus' sake, so that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh. **12** So death works in us, but life in you. 2 Cor 4:7-12
