Genesis 15:5 And he brought him forth abroad, and said, **Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them:** and he said unto him, **So shall thy seed be.**

6 And **he believed in the Lord;** and he counted it to him for righteousness.

Romans 4:3 For what saith the scripture?

Abraham **believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.**

4 Now to him that worketh is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt.

5 But to him that **worketh not, but **believeth** on him that justifieth the ungodly, his **faith** is counted for righteousness.**

Romans 4:13 For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.

16 Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise **might be sure** to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Billy Graham:

Mark 16:12 After that he appeared in another form unto two of them, as they walked, and went into the country.

13 And they went and told it unto the residue: **neither believed they them.**

14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and **upbraided them with their unbelief** and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.

Matthew 9:28 And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, **Believe** ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord.

29 Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your **faith** be it unto you.

John 4:39 And many of the Samaritans of that city **believed** on him for the **saying of the woman,** which testified, He told me all that ever I did.

John 12:42 Nevertheless among the chief rulers also many **believed on him; but because of the Pharisees they **did not confess** him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue:**

Titus 3:8 This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have **believed in God might be careful to **maintain good works**. These things are good and profitable unto men.**

14 And let ours also learn to **maintain good works for necessary uses, that they be not unfruitful.**

13 For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself,

15 And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.

James 2:1 My brethren, have not the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with respect of persons.

21 Was not Abraham our father justified by works, **when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar?**

22 Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect?

23 And the scripture **was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was **called the Friend of God.****

24 Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and **not by faith only.**

said before...**

**Job 38:36 Who hath put
wisdom in the inward parts?
or who hath given
understanding to the heart?**

testimony of our
conscience...**
