Honor Marriage Matthew 19:1-12

Main Point:

Because you are the Bride of Christ, honor marriage as God has designed it, despite the difficulties.

- 1. Marriage is full of difficulties.
- 2. Some people respond to the difficulties of marriage by getting a divorce.
- 3. Marriage is a lifelong commitment of faithfulness to your spouse.
- 4. Others respond to the difficulties of marriage by avoiding it altogether.
- 5. Marriage is the normal state for mankind.
- 6. Because you are the Bride of Christ, honor marriage as God has designed it, despite the difficulties.

Deuteronomy 24:1-4 ¹ "When a man takes a wife and marries her, and it happens that she finds no favor in his eyes because he has found some uncleanness in her, and he writes her a certificate of divorce, puts *it* in her hand, and sends her out of his house, ² "when she has departed from his house, and goes and becomes another man's *wife*, ³ "*if* the latter husband detests her and writes her a certificate of divorce, puts *it* in her hand, and sends her out of his house, or if the latter husband dies who took her as his wife, ⁴ "*then* her former husband who divorced her must not take her back to be his wife after she has been defiled; for that *is* an abomination before the LORD, and you shall not bring sin on the land which the LORD your God is giving you *as* an inheritance. (NKJV)

Malachi 2:16a ¹⁶ "For the LORD God of Israel says That He hates divorce ... (NKJV)

- **1 Corinthians 7:12b-15** ¹² ... If any brother has a wife who does not believe, and she is willing to live with him, let him not divorce her. ¹³ And a woman who has a husband who does not believe, if he is willing to live with her, let her not divorce him. ¹⁴ For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband; otherwise your children would be unclean, but now they are holy. ¹⁵ But if the unbeliever departs, let him depart; a brother or a sister is not under bondage in such *cases*. But God has called us to peace. (NKJV)
