¹ Affections = Jonathan Edwards' "Religious Affections". These are opposites like delight/abhor, "feel safe"/fear, like/dislike, etc. which attract or repel the will from making a choice.

Assumes commands are directed at a person's will. The will is the aspect of the heart that makes a choice. Zeal/apathy, confidence/doubt, etc. measure the will's intensity.
