What Tolerance of Sin Cost the Church

- 1. The church loses its **sensitivity** to sin (verses 1-2) Yet
 - a. There was no shock -
 - b. There was no **shame** –
 - c. There was no **sorrow** –
 - d. There was no sadness -
- 2. The church loses its ability to **discern evil** (verses 3-5)
- 3. The church loses it capacity to **influence** the world (verses 6-8).
 - **a.** Leaven (sin) if not removed is a growing **contamination**.
 - b. Leaven (sin) if left unchecked will make the new lump look like the old lump.
 - c. Leaven (sin) if allowed to grow will rob the church of **joy**.
- 4. The Church loses its capability to **apply God's word** to itself. (verses 9-13)
- **5.** The Church **loses**
 - a. 1 Cor 3:16-17
- 6. Ephesians 3:21
- 7. Three questions:
 - a. Am I living like this because I do it by nature? <u>Then "I've</u> never really been saved"
 - **b.** Am I living like this because I do against my nature? **Then**"I'm saved but not acting like it."
 - **c.** Am I insensitive to sin because I've gotten used to it? **Then I need to repent!**
