QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

- 1. What is happening to David that leads him to pray this prayer? What is David longing for?
- 2. When David appeals to his righteousness, is he claiming to be perfect? Why is he pointing to his obedience to God's word?
- 3. What is the conscience? How can we have a clean conscience like David?
- 4. What OT songs was David remembering as he prayed in vv. 7-8? What does this show us about the relationship between the Bible and prayer?
- 5. Where do unbelievers place their hope? Believers? What difference does this make in the midst of persecution?
- 6. Jesus said that the psalms spoke of Him (Lk. 24:44). How does He ultimately fulfill this psalm and how does the church fulfill it as they share in His sufferings?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

- 1. When was the last time I suffered opposition or hostility from the world? Given 2 Timothy 3:12, what does this say about my godliness?
- 2. Do false accusations and enmity tend to drive me to self-pity, anger, or fear? Or do they drive me to God?
- 3. Is my present walk and future hope ordered by the word? Are my feet gripped to God's path and my inheritance in future glory? How might this reorient my response to persecution?
