live Bi	blically	, the Believer must have in their mind that the Scriptures are their authority for		
living.	In his	Outlines of Theology, Dr. Charles Hodges makes this statement: "Q. What is meant by saying		
that 1	the Scr	iptures are the only infallible rule of faith and practice? A. Whatever God teaches, or commands		
is of s	sovereig	on authority. Whatever conveys to us an infallible knowledge of his teachings and commands is an		
infalli	ble rule	The Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are the only organs through which, during the		
prese	nt dispe	ensation, God conveys to us a knowledge of his will about what we are to believe concerning		
himse	of and	what duties he requires of us." For the Believer, the only thing that we have to verify the		
autho	rity of	the Scripture is what the Scripture says about, and our faith in the Scriptures.
