## v 5-15 Their Mission

- v 5 had OT restrictions, Acts 10:28
- v 6 was needful, Jer 50:6
- v 7 was <u>hopeful</u> (i.e. a *gospel* )... <u>at hand</u>, Isaiah 25:9, 26:8, 33:2
- v 8 was <u>full</u> and <u>free</u>
- v 9-10 was supported by grateful believers, 2 Kings 5:15, Acts 28:8-10
- v 11-13a brought peace and blessing to the worthy = see v 14
- v 13b-15 or brought judgment to the rejectors. John 15:22

## v 16--25 Persecution Predicted

beware of...councils (a) civic, Acts 25:12 and (b) religious, Mt 12:14

- e.g. Council of Nicaea, 325 AD omitted
  - 1. The Absolute Authority of the Bible = faith
  - 2. The Gospel of Christ alone saves = love
  - 3. The Second Coming of Christ = hope
