## 071022A INTRODUCTION

- 1. A17:29 concludes body [v22-29]: v30-31 = applies. 2 fndtns: 1] God is our Creator; 2] We are image of God.
  - i. Paul assumes their awareness of the existence of God suppress & exchange Rm 1:18-23
  - ii. We must be careful when we are told to find "legitimacy" in idolatry. Natural theology is found in false religion. False religion is idolatrous, but man's awareness of God gives us a point of contact for the gospel.
- 2. Having focused on God, now on man as image of God v28b-29

## 1st: It is foolish to think that the Creator can be created by a creature out of creation - v29

- 1. Smthg in paganism to affirm poet Aretas: humans are *children of God*. Not "child" but "generation". Refutes Athenian "racial superiority".
- **2.** We are like God, but God is not like us. Man is made by God [image of God], God is not made by man as image of Man. Rm 11:36
  - i. "Human" is defined by Creation Gn 1:27
  - ii. Man as image o f God fulfilled in Jesus.
- **3.** We <u>shroud</u> know selves in rln to God. Calvin 1st teach God, then self [although in our experience we are 1st self aware].
- **4.** v30 *God is now declaring* = special revelation. In view is pagan's hope the gods will protect from jdgmnt [v31]. 1st indict foolish, disobedient thinking re: God *we ought not to think* as you think about *the Divine Nature*!
  - i. think
  - ii. ought not
  - iii. Divine Nature: we are responsible to God for the way we think about God. Translated <u>divine</u> in 2Pt 1:2-4. Creator//creature. Synonym in Rm 1:20. God is divine, not creature.
- **5.** The immorality of physical idols made by men's technology.
  - i. gold, silver or stone

- ii. image:
- iii. formed by man's art = "technology"
- iV. Futility of idols Gal 4:8; A19:26.
- **6.** Men that idols = *divine nature*. Academics & *that of man:* imagination. See Jeroboam 1Kg 12:33. 3 kinds of Gentile paganism: 1] folk; 2] civic; 3] philosophical.
- 7. <u>A17:29</u> The issue: how do we think of the Being of God [determines how we think of selves & reality].
  - i. The Being of God is not a *being like* He is "a se" [aseity].
  - ii. God's being is who God is. His essence is His existence. God IS. All else BECOMES.
- **8.** Paul threatens all that is Athenian.
  - i. 1st he has confronted them w/ their ignorance of God. See Jesus w/ Pharisees Jn 9. Their projections of themselves onto "gods" inevitably limits the "definition" of God.
  - ii. 2nd he tells them their assumptions about reality are wrong, not just inaccurate, but immoral, disobedient Rm 1:25. Sophisticated fools. They're wrong about God & they're wrong to be wrong about God.
- 9. Let's review
  - i. <u>v22-23</u> idolatry evidences of ignorance of God who is known.
  - ii. <u>v24</u> foolish to try to contain the Creator w/i man-made container
  - iii.  $\underline{v25}$  foolish to try to sustain the life of the God who gives & sustains life. Men do not feed God, He sustains us.
  - iV.  $\underline{v26}$  foolish to think the God who made all men is not God of all men.
  - V. <u>v27-28a</u> foolish not to seek the God who is near
  - Vi. <u>v29</u>- foolish to think that the Creator can be created by a creature out of creation
  - Vii. Repeated "foolish" "fool" = someone who is ignorant of God. They are aware of God as *the unknown god*.

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10. In v30- applications: repent in view of gospel of resurrected Jesus.
