"Proof Of Love" Romans 5:6-8 **Introduction:** We've Been Singing This Morning: 1. - Simple Songs: - That Deal With: - One Of The Most Profound Truths: - That We Find In The Bible! - The Truth That: - "Jesus Loves Even Me!" - And That - Jesus Loves Even: - You! As We Continue Our Series: 2. - Through The Book Of Romans - On Sunday Mornings: - Please Turn With Me To: - Romans 5 - Where - In The Last Verse We Visited - Verse 5: - We Were Told That For All Believers In Christ: - "The Love Of God Is Shed Abroad - Or - Is Being Continuously Poured Out -Into Our Hearts By The Holy Spirit!" But - How Is This Accomplished? 3. - Especially When There Are Times In Your Life: - When You Suffer & When You Struggle: - And You May Even Start To Wonder: - If Jesus Does Love Even Me! - Well - In The Verses We Come To Next: - In 5:6-8 - We Find The Proof Of God's Love: - Especially In A Verse That You Probably Know Quite Well: - 5:8 - "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us!" - The Proof Of God's Love For You: - Is The Death Of Christ: - For You! - Even When You Were: - The Most Unlovely - And: - The Most Unloveable! - Even As A Sinner: - "Christ Died For You!" - And That Is Why - No Matter What You Are Going Through: - God's Love For You Shines Out All The More: - Against The Back-Drop Of Your Unloveliness! And So - In These Three Verses: 4. - We Find Four Descriptions: - Of Our Unloveliness: - Which Serve To Highlight: - The Love Of God: - To Us! - 5:6-8 - "For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. / For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. / But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us!"

* The First Description We Find Is That We Have:

1. A Condition That Is Weak!

- Even As We Are Told Again In:

- 5:6a - "For When We Were Yet Without Strength!"

- The Word Here Translated "Without Strength" Can Also Be Translated:

- Weak & Sick, Feeble & Infirm!

- It Is Often Used In The Bible To Describe Someone Who Is:

- Physically Weak - But It Can Also Be Used To Describe:

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- All Weakness And Feebleness, Which Is The Result Of The
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Fall!

- IE: And The Truth Is - We Are All Very, Very Weak! Just Look At What A Little Virus, About 100 Nano-Meters In Size, Which Is 1/1000th The Width Of A Human Hair - And Look At What Has It Done To This World! To Us! Our Condition Is Very, Very Weak! And:

- Our Weakness Is Extensive!

- Not Only Are We Weak Physically:

- We Are Weak Morally & Spiritually As Well!

- The Bible Reveals That:

- Our Physical Weakness Even Stems From Our Spiritual Weakness!

- In Isaiah 1:4-6 - Our Spiritual Infirmities:

- Are Put In Physical Terms:

- "Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward. / Why should ye be stricken any more? ye will revolt more and more: the whole head is sick, and the whole heart faint. / From the sole of the foot even unto the head there is no soundness in it; but wounds, and bruises, and putrifying sores: they have not been closed, neither bound up, neither mollified with ointment!"

- But - Lest We Think That:

- Our Weakness Means:

- That There May Still Be Some Strength Or Ability:

- Left In Us:

- Our Weakness Is [Further] Exposed:

- In The Bible - As Death Itself!

- In Ephesians 2:1 - Paul Reminds Believers That:

- We "Were Dead In Trespasses And Sins!"

- Can You Be Any Weaker:

- Than Dead?

- Our Condition - Apart From Christ - Is Weak!

- Very Weak!

- We Were All:

- Living In A Spiritual Hospice:

- Where We Were Spiritually, Already Dead!

- We Were Just Waiting For Our Bodies To Catch Up!

- And Yet - Even In This Condition:

- God Loved You!

- How Do You Know? How Can You Tell?

- The Proof Of God's Love:

- Is The Death Of His Son:

- For You!

* Another Description We Find In These Verses - Is That We Had:

1. A Character That Is Warped!

- As We Read In:

- At The End Of 5:6b - Where - Not Only Were We:

- "Without Strength' - We Were Also:

- "Ungodly!"

- "In Due Time, Christ Died For The Ungodly!"

- IE: If You've Ever Worked With Wood - Whether For Building Or Even For Crafts - You Know That Wood Has A Tendency To Warp! And Warping Is Not Just Annoying, It Can Ruin Whatever It Is You Are Trying To Create With That Wood!

- To Warp Means Something Is Not What It Is Supposed To Be!

- A Board Is Supposed To Be Straight! But When There's A Twist Or A Turn In It - It Is Warped!

- And - So It Is With Us!

- God Created Us - Even As He Created Our First Parents, Adam & Eve, To Have A Relationship

With Him! - And That Relationship Was To Be One Of Love And Reverence And Glory! - But - What Happened! Instead Of Reverence, There Was Rebellion! - First - In The Garden Of Eden - And Then - In All Of Our Hearts! - And Ever Since Then: - Our Hearts Have Been Warped! - Twisted & Crooked & Bent: - Away From Purpose Of God In Creating Us! - So - Even Though: - We Were Weak - Yet: - We Still Thought About God: - And Talked About God: - And Treated God: - As Nothing! - And Yet - Even With This Character: - What Did Jesus Christ Do For You? - 5:6b - "Christ Died For The Ungodly!" - Christ Died For You! - And This Is The Proof: - Of God's Love For You! - So - Even Though You And I: - Were Weakened: - By Death - And Even: - Were Worthy: - Of Death - Yet: - When The Time Came: - Jesus Christ Died For You! - Jesus Died: - At The Appointed Time! - Even As We Are Told In: - Galatians 4:4-5 - "But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, / To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons!" - God Had An Plan In Place: - To Redeem You From Your Weak Condition & Your Warped Character: - Even Before The Foundation Of This World! An Eternal Plan! - And - According To That Plan: - And - At Just The Right Time: - He Died For You! Also: - Jesus Died: - At The Appropriate Time! - At The Season: - Of Our Most Extreme Need And Weakness! - When We Were At Our Lowest Point! - When Others Would: - Crush & Conquer Their Enemies: - When They Are Down! - What Did Jesus Do? - He Came Down: - That He Might Raise You Up: - So That You Could "Sit Together In Heavenly Places In Christ Jesus!" (Ephesians 2:6) - Never Forget That: - The Death Of God's Son - For You: - Is The Proof Of God's Love: - For You!

* But - We Find Another Description In 5:7 - And That Is - We Had:

3. A Consideration That Is Wanting!

- 5:7 - "For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die!"

- When Paul Talks About Someone Dying For Another: - He Is Referring To: - A Sacrificial Act: - That Is Based On: - A Selfless Love! - And - Here He Says: - That Such Sacrificial Love: - Is Rare! - After All - Life Is A Very Precious Thing! - And It Is The Most Natural Thing For A Person: - To Want To Survive & To Thrive! - And That Is Why: - Sacrificial Love Is A Scarce Thing: - Even When It Is For: - A "Righteous Man!" - Now - Here - Paul Seems To Be Looking At People The Way The Jews Commonly Did! - A "Righteous" / "Just" Man Was One Who Was Strictly Just! - It Was Someone Who: - Gave To Every One His Due: - No More & No Less! - Their Motto Might Have Been: - "What's Yours Is Yours, But What's Mine Is Mine!" - So - A Just Man: - Would Likely Be: - A Respected Man & An Honored Man: - But Even So - It Would Be A Very Rare Thing: - For You To Lay Down Your Life For That Respectable Man! - But Also: - Sacrificial Love Is A Seldom Thing: - Even When It Is for: - A "Good Man!" - A "Good Man" Was Someone Who Was Compassionate And Known For His / Her Benevolence! - It Was Someone Who: - Gave To Every One *More*: - Than They Were Due! - Their Motto Would Have Been: - "What's Mine Is Yours!" - So - A Good Man: - Would Have Been: - A Beloved Man! - But Even Still - It Would Be A Very Rare Thing: - For You To Lay Down Your Life For That Good Man! - Now - We Know - That There Are Times: - When People Have & Do: - Sacrifice Their Lives For Others! - Jesus Recognizes This And Commends This In John 15:13 - When He Says - "Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends!" - But - This Is Still: - A Very Unusual & A Very Rare Thing: - To Find In This World! - Even For Righteous Men & Good Men! - But - What About You & What About Me? - According To What We've Already Seen In The Book Of Romans:

- Before God - We Are Neither:

- Romans 3:10-12 Reminds Us: - "As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: / There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. / They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one!" - So - If It's A Scarce Thing: - For Righteous Men: - And - If It's A Seldom Thing: - For Good Men: - Then It Must Be An Impossible Thing: - For People Like You And Me! - When We Are Weighed In The Balance: - Apart From Christ: - We Are Found Desperately Wanting! - But - Once Again - This Is Where God's Love Come In, Doesn't It? - Because - Even With This Consideration: - By God Himself: - He Still Loved You! - How Do You Know? How Can You Tell? - 5:8 - "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us!" - We Weren't Even His Friends: - As Of Yet! - We Were Sinners! We Were Even His Enemies, As We Will See In 5:10! - And That Leads Us To Our Fourth Description - Which Is: A Conduct That Is Wicked! - This Is What Sinners Are! - This Is What Sinners Do! - We Were Wicked! - Not Just As A Condition: - But In Our Conduct! - Not Just In Who We Are: - But In What We Do! - Not Just In Our Relationship With God: - Or Lack Thereof - But: - In Our Rebellion Against God! An Active Rebellion! **Conclusion:** But - In Spite Of All This: - 5:8 - "But God Commendeth His Love Toward Us!" - The Word Translated "Commendeth" Here: - Has Also Been Translated: - To Show Or To Demonstrate! - Another Way Of Looking At It Is To Use The Word: - "Exhibit!" - "God Exhibits His Love Toward Us!" - IE: If You've Ever Been To A County Or A State Fair, You Know What An "Exhibit" Is! And The Best Exhibits Are More Than Just Displays - They Are Demonstrations! For Over 150 Years, "World's Fairs Or Expos" Have Been Held - Where Countries Showcase Some Of Their Greatest Attributes & Achievements! Well - The Greatest Exhibition:

- Oh - "How Deep The Father's Love For Us, How Vast Beyond All Measure! That He Should Give His Only Son, To Make A Wretch His Treasure!"

Do You Know This Love Today?

- Have You Responded To This Love?

- IE: At Any Other Exhibit You Might Visit - A Salesman May Demonstrate His Product Or Service - To Those Who Are Able & Willing To Buy!

God Exhibits His Love To Those Who Are Not Only Unable To Respond, But To Those Who Are Unwilling To Respond As Well! - And What Does The Lord Say? - To Unlovely, Ungodly, Ungrateful: - Sinners Like Us? - Isaiah 55:1 - "Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price!" Won't You Respond To God's Love Today? 6. - For The First Time: - Respond By Faith! - Believe On The Lord Jesus Christ: - "Who was delivered for [your] offences, and was raised again for [your] justification!" (4:25)- But Then - For The Rest Of Time & Eternity: - Respond By Love! - 1 John 4:19 - "We Love Him, Because He First Loved Us!"

- And - The Proof Of God's Love:

- Will Ever Remain:

- The Death Of His Son:

- For You!

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
