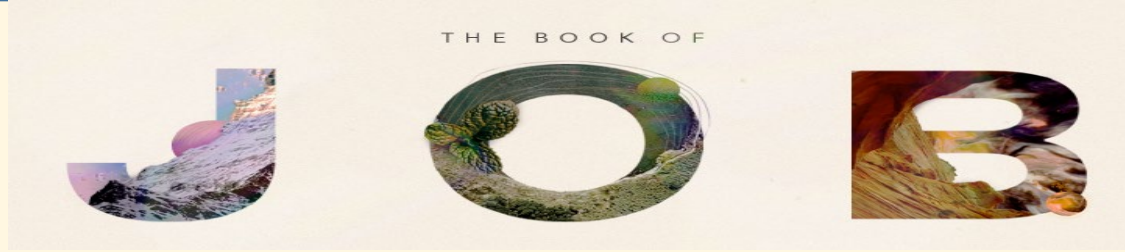
¹ Then Job answered and said,

¹ Then Job replied:

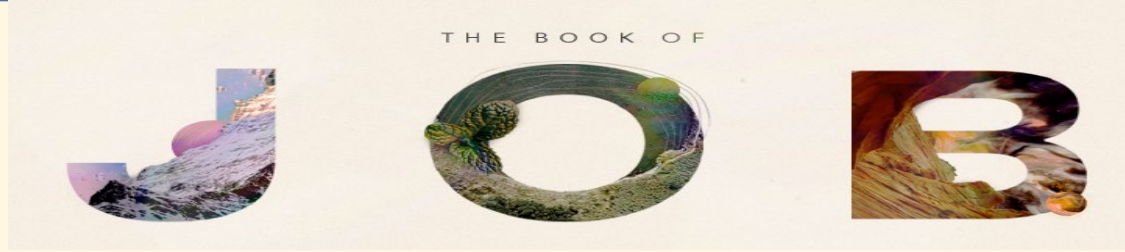


Job 19:2 (KJV)

² How long will ye vex my soul, and break me in pieces with words?

² "How long will you torment me and crush me with words?"



Job 19:3 (KJV)

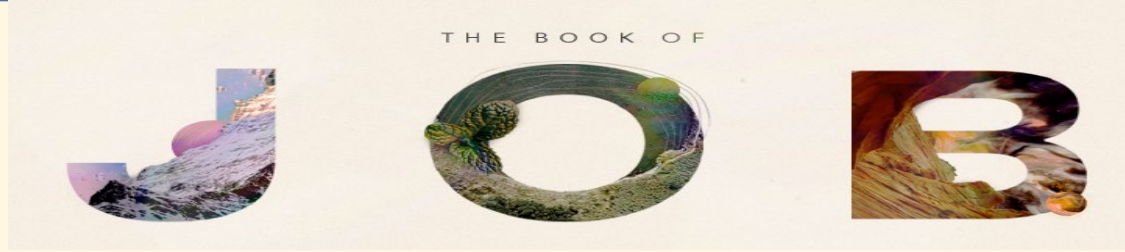
³ These ten times have ye reproached me: ye are not ashamed *that* ye make yourselves strange to me.

³ Time after time you insult me and show no shame for the way you abuse me.

³ Ten times now you have reproached me; shamelessly you attack me.



Job 19:4 (KJV)

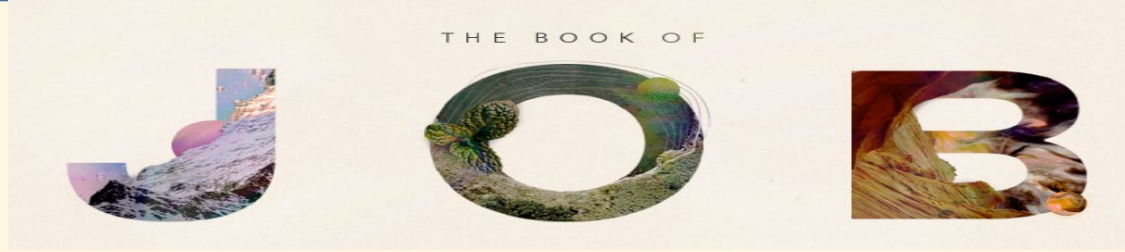
⁴ And be it indeed *that* I have erred, mine error remaineth with myself.

⁴ Even if I have done wrong, how does that hurt you?

⁴ If it is true that I have gone astray, my error remains my concern alone.



Job 19:5 (KJV)

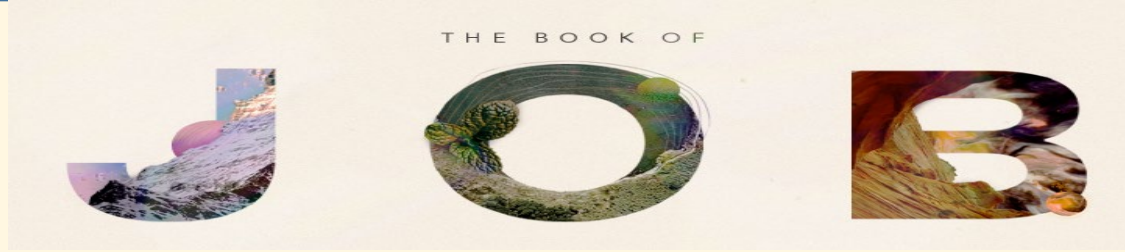
⁵ If indeed ye will magnify yourselves against me, and plead against me my reproach:

⁵ You think you are better than I am, and regard my troubles as proof of my guilt.

⁵ If indeed you would exalt yourselves above me and use my humiliation against me,



Job 19:6 (KJV)

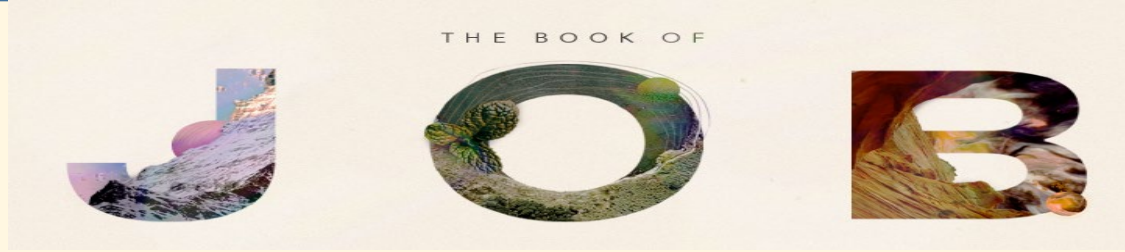
⁶ Know now that God hath overthrown me, and hath compassed me with his net.

Job 19:6 (TEV)

Can't you see it is God who has done this? He has set a trap to catch me.

Job 19:6 (NIV)

then know that God has wronged me and drawn his net around me.



Job 19:7 (KJV)

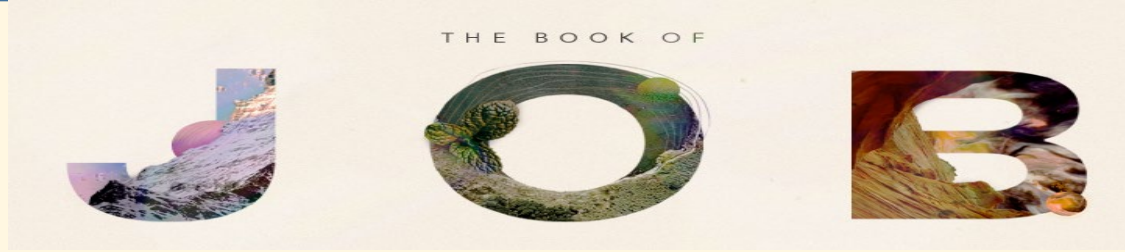
⁷ Behold, I cry out of wrong, but I am not heard: I cry aloud, but *there is no judgment.*

Job 19:7 (TEV)

⁷ I protest his violence, but no one is listening; no one hears my cry for justice.

Job 19:7 (NIV)

⁷ "Though I cry, 'I've been wronged!' I get no response; though I call for help, there is no justice.



Job 19:8 (KJV)

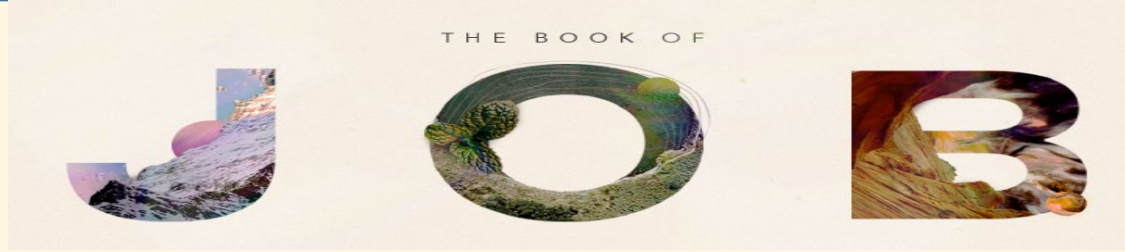
⁸ He hath fenced up my way that I cannot pass, and he hath set darkness in my paths.

Job 19:8 (TEV)

⁸ God has blocked the way, and I can't get through; he has hidden my path in darkness.

Job 19:8 (NIV)

⁸ He has blocked my way so I cannot pass; he has shrouded my paths in darkness.



Job 19:9 (KJV)

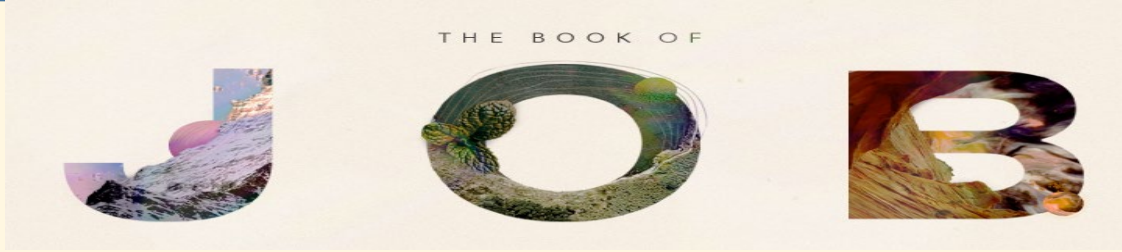
⁹ He hath stripped me of my glory, and taken the crown from my head.

Job 19:9 (TEV)

⁹ He has taken away all my wealth and destroyed my reputation.

Job 19:9 (NIV)

⁹ He has stripped me of my honor and removed the crown from my head.



Job 19:10 (KJV)

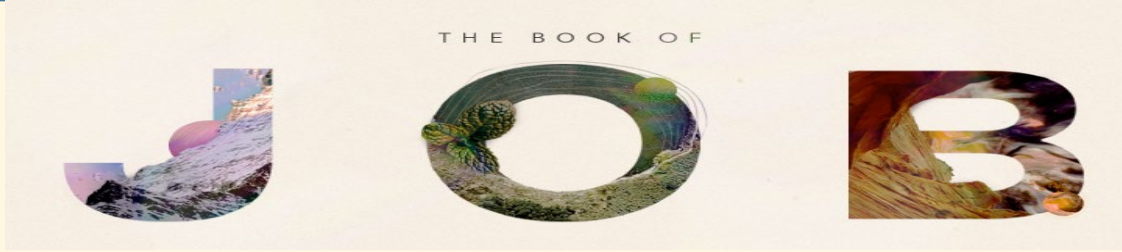
¹⁰ He hath destroyed me on every side, and I am gone: and mine hope hath he removed like a tree.

Job 19:10 (TEV)

¹⁰ He batters me from every side. He uproots my hope and leaves me to wither and die.

Job 19:10 (NIV)

¹⁰ He tears me down on every side till I am gone; he uproots my hope like a tree.



Job 19:11 (KJV)

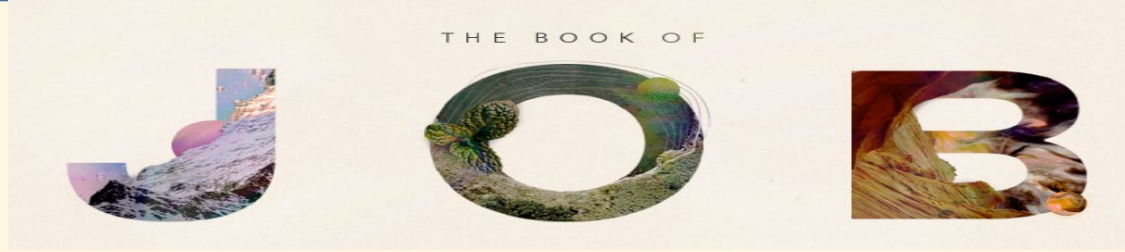
¹¹ He hath also kindled his wrath against me, and he counteth me unto him as *one of* his enemies.

Job 19:11 (TEV)

¹¹ God is angry and rages against me; he treats me like his worst enemy.

Job 19:11 (NIV)

¹¹ His anger burns against me; he counts me among his enemies.



Job 19:12 (KJV)

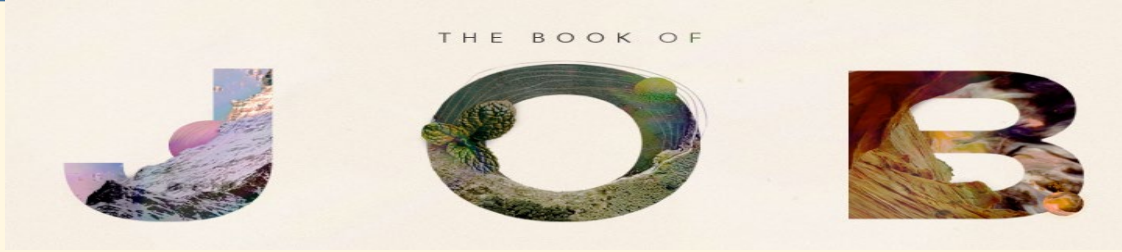
¹² His troops come together, and raise up their way against me, and encamp round about my tabernacle.

Job 19:12 (TEV)

¹² He sends his army to attack me; they dig trenches and lay siege to my tent.

Job 19:12 (NIV)

¹² His troops advance in force; they build a siege ramp against me and encamp around my tent.



Job 19:13 (KJV)

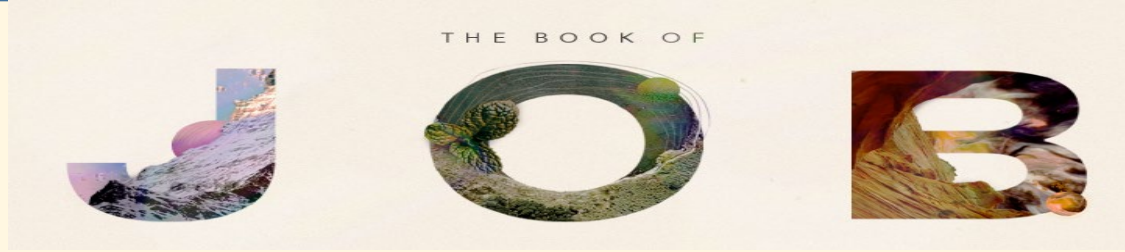
¹³ He hath put my brethren far from me, and mine acquaintance are verily estranged from me.

Job 19:13 (TEV)

¹³ God has made my own family forsake me; I am a stranger to those who knew me;

Job 19:13 (NIV)

¹³ "He has alienated my brothers from me; my acquaintances are completely estranged from me.



Job 19:14 (KJV)

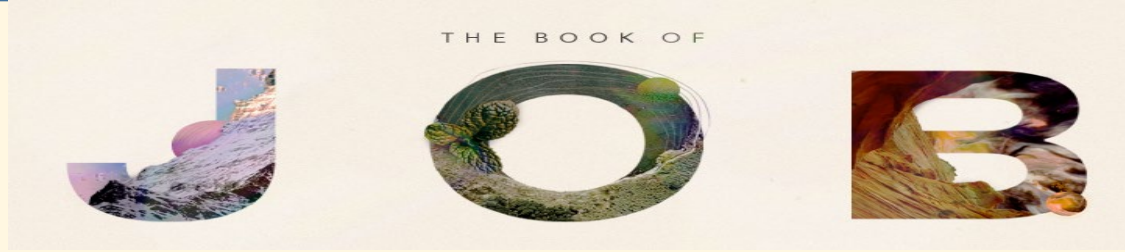
¹⁴ My kinsfolk have failed, and my familiar friends have forgotten me.

Job 19:14 (TEV)

¹⁴ my relatives and friends are gone.

Job 19:14 (NIV)

¹⁴ My kinsmen have gone away; my friends have forgotten me.



Job 19:15 (KJV)

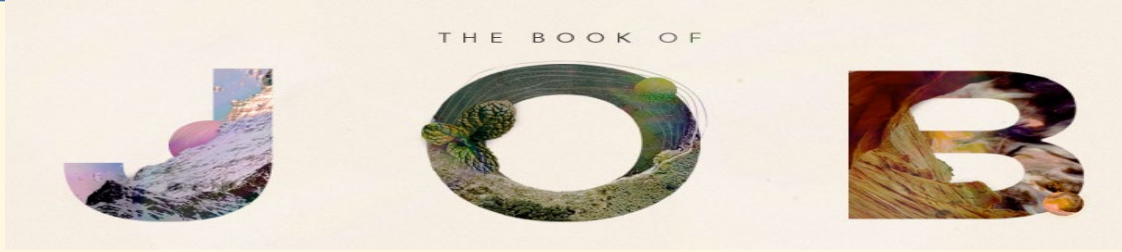
¹⁵ They that dwell in mine house, and my maids, count me for a stranger: I am an alien in their sight.

Job 19:15 (TEV)

¹⁵ Those who were guests in my house have forgotten me; my servant women treat me like a stranger and a foreigner.

Job 19:15 (NIV)

¹⁵ My guests and my maidservants count me a stranger; they look upon me as an alien.



Job 19:16 (KJV)

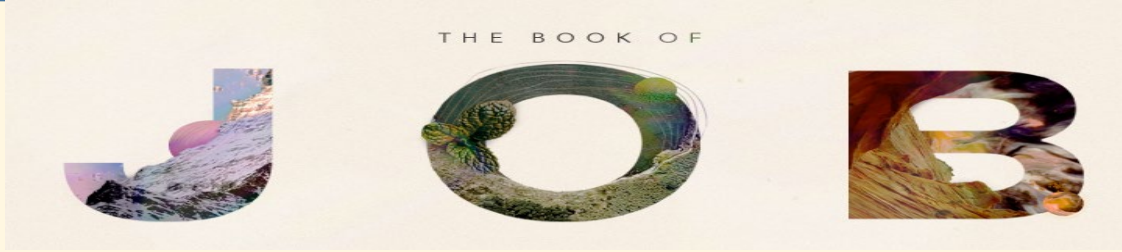
¹⁶ I called my servant, and he gave *me* no answer; I intreated him with my mouth.

Job 19:16 (TEV)

¹⁶ When I call a servant, he doesn't answer— even when I beg him to help me.

Job 19:16 (NIV)

¹⁶ I summon my servant, but he does not answer, though I beg him with my own mouth.



Job 19:17 (KJV)

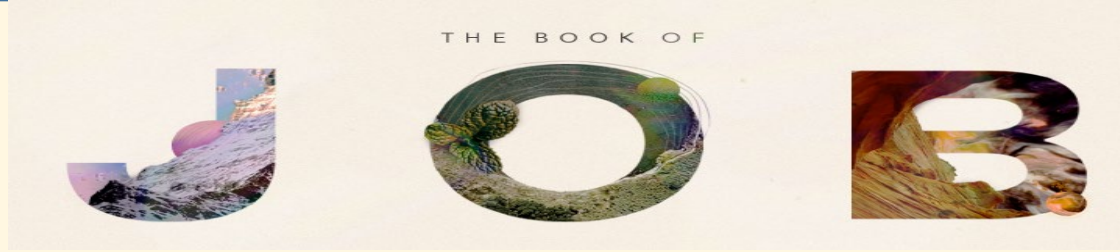
¹⁷ My breath is strange to my wife, though I intreated for the children's *sake* of mine own body.

Job 19:17 (TEV)

¹⁷ My wife can't stand the smell of my breath, and my own brothers won't come near me.

Job 19:17 (NIV)

¹⁷ My breath is offensive to my wife; I am loathsome to my own brothers.



Job 19:18 (KJV)

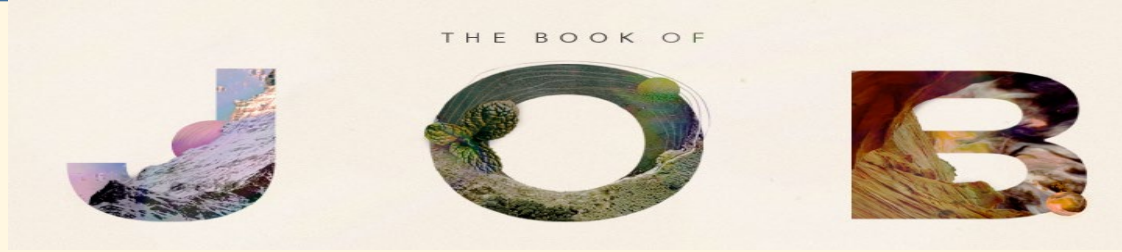
¹⁸ Yea, young children despised me; I arose, and they spake against me.

Job 19:18 (TEV)

¹⁸ Children despise me and laugh when they see me.

Job 19:18 (NIV)

¹⁸ Even the little boys scorn me; when I appear, they ridicule me.



Job 19:19 (KJV)

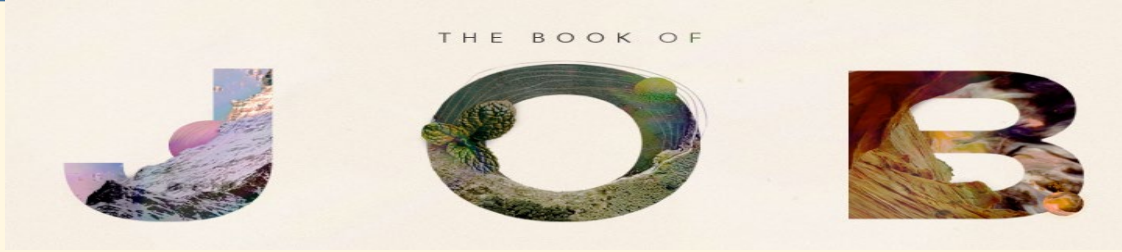
¹⁹ All my inward friends abhorred me: and they whom I loved are turned against me.

Job 19:19 (TEV)

¹⁹ My closest friends look at me with disgust; those I loved most have turned against me.

Job 19:19 (NIV)

¹⁹ All my intimate friends detest me; those I love have turned against me.



Job 19:20 (KJV)

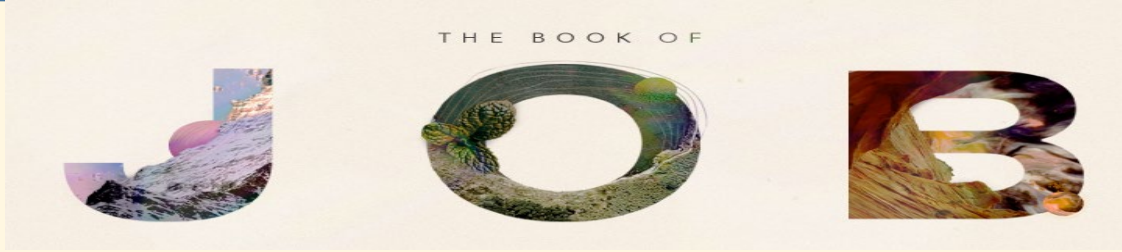
²⁰ My bone cleaveth to my skin and to my flesh, and I am escaped with the skin of my teeth.

Job 19:20 (TEV)

²⁰ My skin hangs loose on my bones; I have barely escaped with my life.

Job 19:20 (NIV)

²⁰ I am nothing but skin and bones; I have escaped with only the skin of my teeth.



Job 19:21 (KJV)

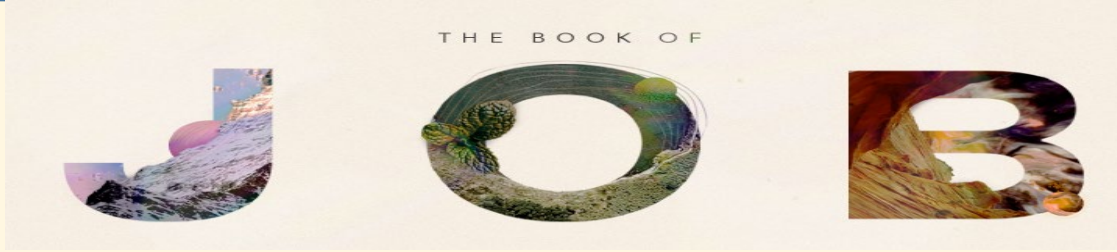
21 Have pity upon me, have pity upon me, O ye my friends; for the hand of God hath touched me.

Job 19:21 (TEV)

21 You are my friends! Take pity on me! The hand of God has struck me down.

Job 19:21 (NIV)

21 "Have pity on me, my friends, have pity, for the hand of God has struck me.



Job 19:22 (KJV)

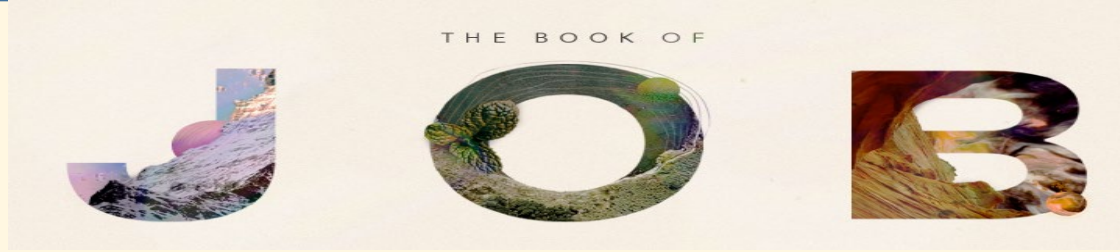
22 Why do ye persecute me as God, and are not satisfied with my flesh?

**22 Why must you persecute me the way God does?
Haven't you tormented me enough?**

Job 19:23 (KJV)

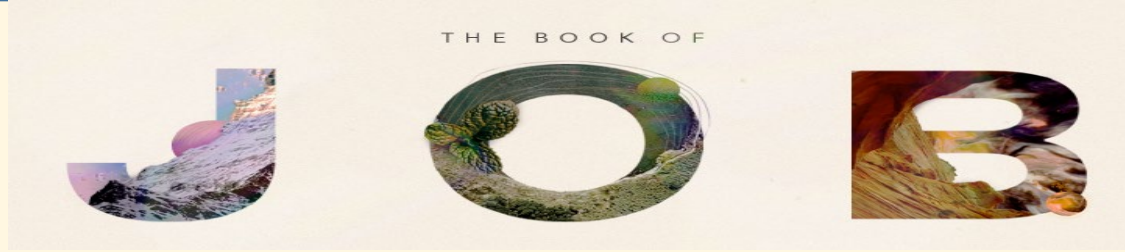
²³ Oh that my words were now written! oh that they were printed in a book!

Job 19:24 (KJV)

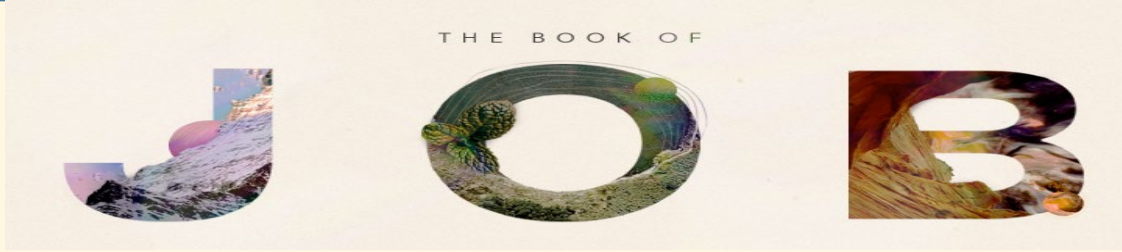
24 That they were graven with an iron pen and lead in the rock for ever!

Job 19:24 (TEV)

24 Or with a chisel carve my words in stone and write them so that they would last forever.

Job 19:25 (KJV)

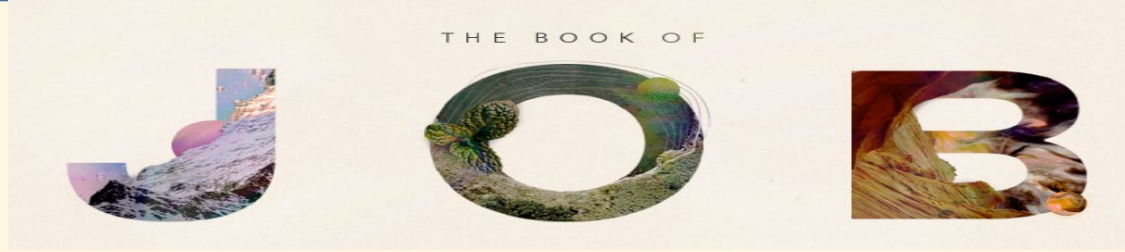
25 For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth:

Job 19:26 (KJV)

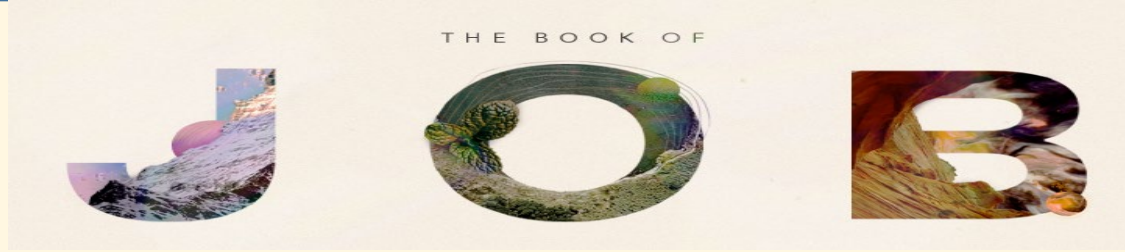
26 And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see God:

Job 19:26 (TEV)

26 Even after my skin is eaten by disease, while still in this body I will see God.

26 And after my skin has been destroyed, yet in my flesh I will see God;



Job 19:27 (KJV)

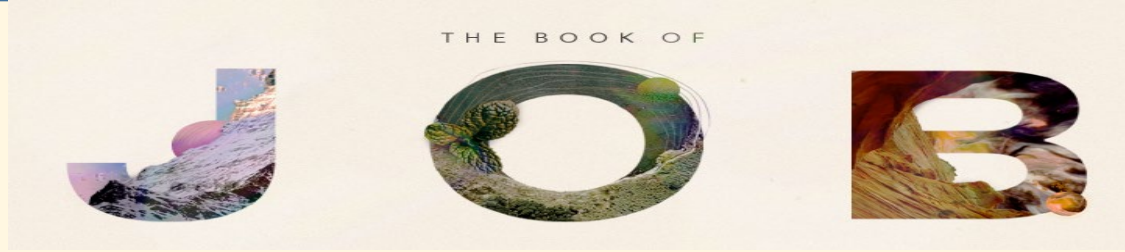
²⁷ Whom I shall see for myself, and mine eyes shall behold, and not another; *though* my reins be consumed within me.

Job 19:27 (TEV)

²⁷ I will see him with my own eyes, and he will not be a stranger. My courage failed because you said,

Job 19:27 (NIV)

²⁷ I myself will see him with my own eyes--I, and not another. How my heart yearns within me!



Job 19:28 (KJV)

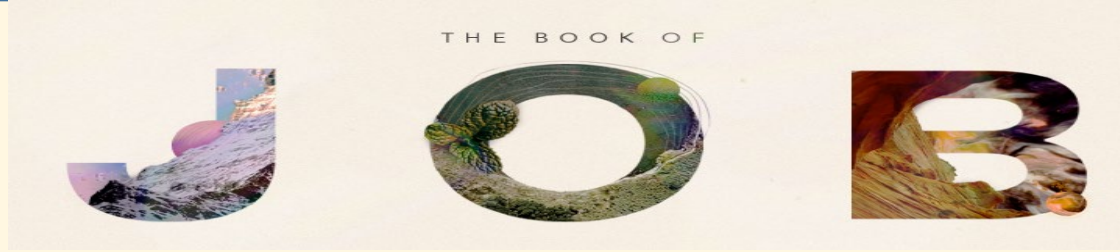
28 But ye should say, Why persecute we him, seeing the root of the matter is found in me?

Job 19:28 (TEV)

28 "How can we torment him?" You looked for some excuse to attack me.

Job 19:28 (NIV)

28 "If you say, 'How we will hound him, since the root of the trouble lies in him,'



Job 19:29 (KJV)

²⁹ Be ye afraid of the sword: for wrath bringeth the punishments of the sword, that ye may know there is a judgment.

Job 19:29 (TEV)

²⁹ But now, be afraid of the sword— the sword that brings God's wrath on sin, so that you will know there is one who judges.

Job 19:29 (NIV)

²⁹ you should fear the sword yourselves; for wrath will bring punishment by the sword, and then you will know that there is judgment."
