Authority of Government

Rom. 13:1 Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God. 2 Therefore whoever resists the authorities resists what God has appointed, and those who resist will incur judgment. 3 For rulers are not a terror to good conduct, but to bad. Would you have no fear of the one who is in authority? Then do what is good, and you will receive his approval, 4 for he is God's servant for your good. But if you do wrong, be afraid, for he does not bear the sword in vain. For he is the servant of God, an avenger who carries out God's wrath on the wrongdoer. 5 Therefore one must be in subjection, not only to avoid God's wrath but also for the sake of conscience. 6 For because of this you also pay taxes, for the authorities are ministers of God, attending to this very thing. 7 Pay to all what is owed to them: taxes to whom taxes are owed, revenue to whom revenue is owed, respect to whom respect is owed, honor to whom honor is owed.

1st - God is the Source of All Authority

John 19:8 When Pilate heard what they said, he was more afraid than ever, **9** and he went back into the governor's residence and said to Jesus, "Where do you come from?" But Jesus gave him no answer. **10** So Pilate said, "Do you refuse to speak to me? Don't you know I have the authority to release you, and to crucify you? **11** Jesus replied, "You would have no authority over me at all, unless it was given to you from above. Therefore the one who handed me over to you is guilty of greater sin."

Authority of the Church


Matt. 16:18 And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock <u>I will build my church</u>, and the gates of Hades will not overpower it.



Should Christians Disobey Government?

1Pet. 2:13 Be subject for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether it be to the emperor as supreme, **14** or to governors as <u>sent by him</u> to punish those who do evil and to praise those who do good. **15** For this is the will of God, that by doing good you should put to silence the ignorance of foolish people. **16** Live as people who are free, <u>not using your freedom as a cover-up for evil, but living as servants of God</u>. **17** Honor everyone. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the emperor.

Christians Disobeying Ungodly Laws

Total Depravity

Francis Schaeffer wrote:

Since their concept of man is mistaken, their concept of society and of law is mistaken, and they have no sufficient base for either society or law. (A Christian Manifesto, p26)

The humanists push for "freedom," but having no Christian consensus to contain it, that "freedom" leads to chaos or to slavery under the state (or under an elite). Humanism, with its lack of any final base for values or law, always leads to chaos. It then naturally leads to some form of authoritarianism to control the chaos. (A Christian Manifesto, p29-30)

Constitution

Declaration of Independence...July 4, 1776:

The unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America, When in the Course of human events, <u>it becomes necessary</u> for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the <u>Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them</u>, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are <u>endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights</u>, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.--That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, <u>deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed</u>, --That whenever any Form of Government <u>becomes destructive</u> of these ends, <u>it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new</u>

<u>Government</u>, laying its foundation on such principles and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness.

US Constitution, 1st Amendment

Congress shall <u>make no law</u> respecting an establishment of religion, or <u>prohibiting the free exercise</u> <u>thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech</u>, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.

It is not too strong to say that we are at war, and there are no neutral parties in the struggle. One either confesses that God is the final authority, or one confesses that Caesar is Lord. (Schaeffer, A Christian Manifesto, p116).
