INTRODUCTION

- 1. 2Sam 18 Ahimaaz: a messenger w/o a message.
- **2.** <u>2C5:18-19</u> *ministry of reconciliation* stewards of *word of reconciliation*

1st: We Must Explain God's Activity in Christ

1. v19 - *namely, that*: how that... explanation of v18.

2. What God did & does: objective information communicated & interpreted faithfully: *namely that, specifically, that is...*

2nd: God's Reconciling Activity

1. <u>v19a</u> the verbs: was - reconciling. God's activity v18

2. If we isolate *G* was in Christ, sounds like doct of incarnation. But Paul is describing God's activity in Christ, not the deity of Christ: *God was reconciling* = subject & verb.

3. Interesting verbs: past action coupled w/ ongoing present action: *was* = past action & *reconciling* & *not counting* are participles, ongoing action.

i. *has committed to us* is also past action: having been *reconciled* [v18] God *gave us* ministry of reconcil & *committed to us* word of reconcil

4. v19a - God was acting *thru Christ* [v18], *in Christ* [v19] & continues to act by HS in ministry/word of reconcil: *reconciling & not counting trespasses*

5. Reconciliation concerns what God does - Rm 11:36

3rd: God's Reconciling Activity in Christ

1. We confess the deity of Jesus - divine Messiah, Savior. He is our Mediator [Jn 14:10; 5:19; 17:4; Jn 19:30]

2. God reconciles us *through, in* the resurrected & enthroned Jesus whose mediating ministry involves the work of the HS.

Applic #1: The Gospel is News About God's Activity in Christ

- **1.** Gospel begins w/ indicatives: statements of fact re: the historical Jesus: life, death & resurrection. Jesus is the good news of the gospel
- 2. Our message is "Jesus" in whom God has reconciled us.

Applic #2: The Father, Thru Christ, Has Given Us a Work to Do For Christ

1. <u>Eph 2:10</u> we have a work to do - <u>Tit 2:11-14</u> let us <u>adorn</u> the doctrine of God our Savior: make attractive. A moral beauty - an ordered life & ordered truth.

2. Regardless of our callings - we all have a God-assigned work to do as ministers of this word of reconciliation . Let us not be messengers w/ no message.
