Daniel 11:32

- This verse reveals how important it is to know our God
 - Knowing our God gives strength
- Attribute defined: The term attribute in its application to persons or things, means something belonging to persons or things.
 - J.P. Boyce "The attributes of God are those peculiarities which mark or define the mode of His existence, or which constitute His character."

God is Self-Existent

Exodus 3:14

- The Bible assumes the self-existence of God
- God's self-existence implies His independence Independence means not dependent, free; not subject to control by others; not relying on others; not subordinate; self-sufficient; self-governing; sovereign.

• Acts 17:25-25

- This attribute belongs to God alone
- Hebrews 11:6 "Without faith it is impossible to please Him; for he who comes to God must believe that **He is**, and that is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him."
 - There is great blessing and reward when we believe that He **IS**

- Self-existence speaks also to God's self-sufficiency
 - God is complete in and of Himself
- He is gracious enough to use mankind to accomplish His divine purposes

- Isa. 46:9-11

God is Immutable

- Ps. 102:27; Mal. 3:6
 - God is unchangeable
 - In His nature and purposes
- Hebrews 6:16-19
 - If God changes then we do not have an anchor
 - Job 23:13-14

God is Sovereign

- "But our God is in the heavens; He does whatever He pleases" (Psalm 115:3).
 - If God is not sovereign then He could be changed
- Our faith would be shaken if God was good but not sovereign
