I. Jesus Christ as a Prophet

- A. Jesus was prophesied as a prophet.
- B. Jesus was identified as a prophet.

 - 1. Jesus suffered the despising of a prophet.
 - 2. Jesus suffered the distrust of a prophet.
 - 3. Jesus suffered the death of a prophet.

II. Jesus Christ as a Priest

- A. Jesus made a Priest.
 - 1. Jesus was made a priest after His suffering.
 - 2. Jesus has gone before us and was made a priest.
 - 3. Jesus filled the duties of a priest.
- B. Jesus' manner of Priesthood.
 - 1. His priesthood is eternal.
 - 2. His priesthood is of a different order.
 - 3. His priesthood is with a different tabernacle.
 - 4. His priesthood has a different sacrifice.
- C. Jesus' ministry of a Priest.
 - 1. His is a glorious priesthood.
 - 2. He is a mediator.
 - 3. He is our advocate.
 - 4. He is our intercessor.

III. Jesus Christ as a Potentate (King)

- A. Jesus wanted as a King.

- B. Jesus waiting for His kingdom.
 - 1. He will be King and will sit on the throne of David.
 - 2. He is currently seated in Heaven.
- C. Jesus winning His kingdom.
 - 1. When He comes again, He will be revealed as King.
 - 2. He will be given a kingdom.
 - 3. He will establish His kingdom by conquest at the end of the Tribulation period.
