**HEBREWS: The absolute greatness of Jesus as Son—Part 8**

(So that God's people will not become complacent and compromise, but persevere)

Sermon: **Hebrews 6:1 (let us go on to perfection)**

*Because of the greatness of Jesus, believers are to go on to maturity.*

We see:

1. The rebuke which leads to this duty of maturity (5:11-14).
2. The serious warning in hearing this duty (6:4-8).
3. The confident assurance of God's promise in this duty (6:9-20).

the pillar and ground of the truth (1Tim. 3:15,16)

**The Westminster Confession of Faith**

**WCF 10.1** All those whom God hath predestinated unto life, and those only, He is pleased, in His appointed and accepted time, effectually to call,(1) by His Word and Spirit,(2) out of that state of sin and death in which they are by nature, to grace and salvation by Jesus Christ;(3) enlightening their minds spiritually and savingly to understand the things of God;(4) taking away their heart of stone, and giving unto them a heart of flesh;(5) renewing their wills, and, by His almighty power determining them to that which is good;(6) and effectually drawing them to Jesus Christ;(7) yet so as they come most freely, being made willing by His grace.(8)

**WCF 17.1** They, whom God hath accepted in His Beloved, effectually called and sanctified by His Spirit, can neither totally nor finally fall away from the state of grace; but shall certainly persevere therein to the end, and be eternally saved.(1)

**WCF 17.2** This perseverance of the saints depends not upon their own free will, but upon the immutability of the decree of election, flowing from the free and unchangeable love of God the Father;(1) upon the efficacy of the merit and intercession of Jesus Christ;(2) the abiding of the Spirit, and of the seed of God within them;(3) and the nature of the covenant of grace;(4) from all which ariseth also the certainty and infallibility thereof.(5)

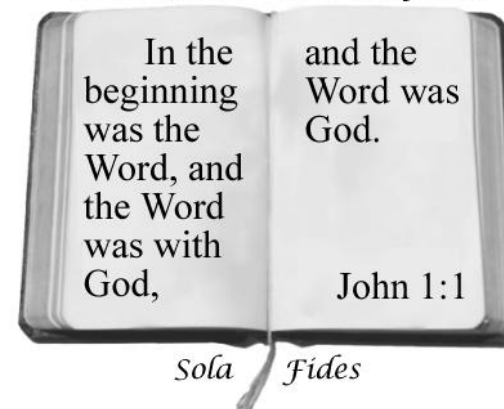
