Pointing us to Jesus

(Hebrews 5:5-9; 1 John 1:7)

(Vs. 57-60)

Jesus' Prayer: You are my portion - nothing else works, but doing things Your way.

(John 10:30; Lamentations 3:24; Lamentations 3:19-26)

The Christian's Prayer: You are my portion - nothing else works but doing things Your way.

(1 John 1:7; Galatians 5:16; John 15; Matthew 11; John 10; 1 Corinthians 10:13)

(vs. 61-62)

Jesus' Prayer: I am staying focused amid the wicked.

(Mark 1:35; Hebrews 12:1-3)

The Christian's Prayer: I am staying focused amid the wicked.

(vs. 63-64)

Jesus' Prayer: Jesus' fellowship is with believers. Common grace and mercy motivated Him to pray to learn more of God's word.

(John 8:31; John 15:14; Psalm 16:3; Matthew 5:44-45; Luke 6:35)

The Christian's Prayer: Our fellowship is with believers. Common grace and mercy motivate us to pray to learn more of God's word.

(1 John 1:3; Matthew 11:29; 1 Peter 2:21)
