Revelation 11:14 plus

Continuing the trumpet judgments, right at the middle point of the tribulation period, and they are affecting the earth and the people, but the worst is yet to happen. Don't spiritualize these judgments – they are real and literal just like it says.

The Two Witnesses

Who are these 2 witnesses? Let's look at Malachi 4:5 – most people believe Malachi is one of the two witnesses spoken of in Rev 11 because of Mal4:5. There is lots of speculation about who the other witness is, but we just don't know who the other witness is. That information has not been given to us yet.

Zechariah 4:1-14: The number 7 in scripture always means complete. Zechariah is the prophet representation as evidenced by his vision of talking with the Lord. Zerubbabel in vs6 was the grandson of the last king of Israel and he was sent to rebuild and he represents the Kingly side of Israel. Ch3-8: Joshua the High Priest... he is with Zerubbabel and represents the priestly side of Israel. The Lord says it will all get done, but not by man's might or power, but by His Spirit. Vs10: "For who hath despised the day of small things?" Don't ever think that something small can't be used for God. God took a little girl who saved 57 cents and a desire to build a Sunday School for kids, and after she died, He grew that 57 cents into the Temple Baptist Church in Philadelphia, PA along with the Good Samaritan Hospital. God can make huge things out of small things with great desires to serve God.

Rev11:12-14: 2 woes have past, 6 trumpets have past, and the 3rd woe and last trumpet are about to start. This last woe and trumpet go all the way thru the end of Rev 20:3.
